## FMH Exam

### *FMH-exam for Neurology:*

- **Written part:** 120 multiple choice questions, a minimum of 2/3 must be answered correctly
- **Oral and practical part:** the resident is questioned by two neurological experts. He/She has to take a patient's history and perform a clinical examination of the patient. The resident will then discuss differential diagnoses, further diagnostic steps and possible therapy with the neurological experts. The oral part of the FMH exam can only be taken after a minimum of two years of clinical training and after passing the written part.

## Further requirements

- Within the neurological training the resident has to perform **5 expertise reports**, 3 of which must be performed in Switzerland.
- The resident must attend at least **3 national or international congresses**, the **minimum-time of participation for each congress is 2 days**.
- The resident must attend at least **6 days** of educational courses at the **Swiss Academy for Young Neurologists**; written confirmation of attendance is required.
